1. AGRICULTURE DEVELOPMENT PROG:-

Farmer should not blindly follow what is suggested by others. One has to

understand the principles behind and decide upon what to do based on local situation and available resources. This is the key aspect in SRI method of cultivation.

Use of organic manures:

Organic matter is the food for life forms teeming in the soil. When organic matter is added the microorganisms in the soil multiply manifold. The microorganisms bring nutrients into available form and are made available to them as and when they are needed.

2. RURAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

Organizational collective efforts on issues relating to rural development are carried out. Livelihood issues related to sustainable livelihoods of the poor are discussed. Sector experts, academicians, innovators, practitioners as well as policy advocacy leaders and policy makers are invited to share their experiences, build consensus and define the road map and strategies for ensuring sustainable livelihoods for the poor.

3. POLLUTION CONTROL :-

The Organization conducted Environmental Purification awareness programme in which people were advised using of less polluted fuel, garbage- containers, environmental sanitation and plantation work in the using of environmental friendly goods. They also suggested to tree plantation in the society.

4. REPRODUCTIVE CHILD HEALTH PROGRAMME :-

Collective action through treatment In Health & Family Welfare Programme women were suggested to keep their house neat and clean by proper drainage, environmental sanitation and safe drinking water. Fresh and nutritious food should be eaten for healthy mind and body. 25 house- wives participated in this programme.
